Governor Musgrove Holds Public Meeting In Rosedale

Jackson, MS – Governor Ronnie Musgrove today held a public meeting at the Bolivar County Courthouse in Rosedale, Mississippi. The meeting was an opportunity for Musgrove to meet with the citizens of Rosedale and Bolivar County and discuss issues relevant to the area.

“I want to hear first-hand from the people about their concerns, their questions, and the issues affecting them on a daily basis,” Musgrove said. “The best way to know and understand those issues is by visiting directly with the people.”

Musgrove also took the opportunity to highlight the level of state funding for Bolivar County, by presenting a large check to elected officials that represented the total funding for the 2001-02 cycle. Since July 2001, the county has received a total of \$1,540,079.30. Over \$1.1 million of the funding was through the Department of Human Services; the remainder came through the Mississippi Development Authority for public facilities.
