Governor Musgrove Names Dvorak as Co-Chair of Southern Technology Council

Jackson, MS – Governor Ronnie Musgrove has appointed Dr. Angeline Godwin Dvorak as co-chair of the Southern Technology Council. Musgrove leads the Council as part of his position as incoming chair of the Southern Growth Policies Board.
