Governor Musgrove Presents \$125,715 in CDBG Funds to Town of Alligator

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove presented the Town of Alligator with a check representing \$125,715 in Community Development Block Grant funds. The funds will be used to refurbish the town's only well, replace the town's three sewage pumping stations, and renovate a pump house. Other projects include replacing a chlorinator and necessary construction for the chlorinator supply line.

“Our investments in infrastructure are so important in our efforts to grow Mississippi, and those investments must be made in the small towns as well as the larger cities,” said Musgrove. “We are working to bring quality, high-paying jobs to every part of the state and our success in that work depends on making sure every community meets its basic needs.”
