Governor Musgrove Kicks Off “Computer Blitz Build”

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove helped kick off a “Computer Blitz Build” today in the State Capitol, as 50 students from around the state gathered to build 100 computers in a day. The finished computers will be distributed to public schools.

“We’re not just putting computers in our classrooms, we’re giving our children the keys to a brighter future,” Musgrove said. “We’re demonstrating to the world that Mississippi means business and we’re going to challenge our competition like never before.”

The computer construction effort is supported by ExplorNet Mississippi.

“Much has been said recently about investing in workforce training in Mississippi, and our investment in the “Computers in the Classroom” is an early commitment to that training,” said Musgrove. “By giving students the tools and the technology to begin learning now, we can produce a more highly-skilled workforce for the future.”
