Governor Musgrove Announces Grants to Mississippi Fire Departments

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove today announced that seven fire departments in Mississippi will receive grants under the Assistance to Firefighters Program.

“These grants will assist our local fire departments in providing much needed fire services,” said Governor Musgrove. “Our men and women are on the ground everyday working hard to protect our communities. This will greatly enhance those efforts.”

The Assistance to Firefighters Program is part of the United States Fire Administration (USFA), under the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). These grants are the second round of awards. On July 11, four Mississippi fire departments received grants totaling \$136,850. The fire departments awarded grants are:
