Governor Musgrove Thanks Floyd Kirk For Service to Mississippi

Jackson, MS – Governor Ronnie Musgrove today praised the dedicated service of Floyd Kirk as State Aid Engineer for the Office of State Aid Road Construction. Floyd submitted a letter to Musgrove announcing his retirement due to health concerns.

“Floyd Kirk set a new standard for others to follow with the work he’s done for our state,” Musgrove said. “The infrastructure we put in place in Mississippi, especially with regard to roads, is a strong element in our economic development efforts. Floyd’s role in making those efforts a success is unquestioned.”

Musgrove re-appointed Kirk to an additional four-year term in January. In his letter to Musgrove, Kirk cited unexpected health problems as the reason for stepping down.

“Our sincere thanks for a job well done go out to Floyd, and our prayers are with him for a speedy recovery,” said Musgrove.
