Governor Musgrove Meets with Public Officials Regarding Georgia-Pacific Closure in Gloster

(Gloster, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove met with employees of Georgia-Pacific and public officials today to discuss the scheduled closing of the Georgia-Pacific facility in Gloster. A total of 320 jobs are expected to be eliminated.

“I wanted to talk with the people most directly affected by this situation, and reassure them the state has resources in place to provide training and other support services,” Musgrove said. “We will do everything we can to ease the impact on the Gloster community.”

Joining Musgrove at the meeting were representatives of the Mississippi Development Authority’s Rapid Response Team, the Mississippi Employment Security Commission, the Workforce Investment Network (WIN) in Mississippi and the area’s WIN Job Centers.
