Governor Musgrove Declares State of Emergency For Hurricane Isidore

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove has issued a state of emergency for the entire state in anticipation of the impact of Hurricane Isidore. The storm is expected to reach land around 12:00a.m. Thursday.

“We are doing everything we can to ensure the safety and security of the people of Mississippi, and I want to encourage residents of the Gulf Coast to take every precaution as this storm nears,” Musgrove said. “It is important for people to be aware of the strength and intensity of Isidore and its potential for damage on the Coast.”

The state of emergency also takes measures to protect consumers from price gouging, and will remain in effect until further notice.

“During this time of emergency, we will not stand for people who try to profit from disaster,” said Musgrove.
