Mississippi in Japan

Governor Ronnie Musgrove continued his trade mission to Japan Wednesday with a series of meetings with trade organizations and business leaders in Tokyo.

Wednesday began at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) Office, where Musgrove and Mississippi Development Authority Executive Director Bob Rohrlack met with government trade officials.

After meeting with representatives of JETRO Tokyo, a trade organization, Musgrove met with leaders of Keidanren, formally known as the Japan Federation of Economic Organizations. Founded in 1946, Keidanren is a national business association whose members include more than 1,000 of Japan's leading corporations.

The last formal meeting of the day was with officials from the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI).

Musgrove is scheduled to return to Mississippi late Friday.
