Governor Musgrove to Proclaim “Day of Prayer” In Mississippi

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove plans to proclaim Thursday, May 1, as the “National Day of Prayer” in Mississippi.

“Prayer is an important part of our lives, in so many ways,” Musgrove said. “I pray every day for the courage and strength to do my job, for those who share in that work, for the blessings God has bestowed in my life, and for the people of this state.”

The first National Day of Prayer was proclaimed by the Continental Congress in 1775, and was revised as an annual observance by Congress in 1952.

Musgrove will speak at a “National Day of Prayer” rally scheduled to begin at 5:30p.m. on Thursday, May 1, on the south steps of the State Capitol.
