(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove today announced the awarding of \$124,000 to the town of Glendora for public projects through the Delta Regional Authority (DRA). The funds will be utilized to expand and enhance fire services in the community.

"We want to do everything we can to protect our people in emergency situations, and this is possible only through being prepared before a crisis begins. For this reason, the fire services in Glendora are the recipients of this grant," said Musgrove.

The grant will be utilized for the construction of a fire station in Glendora as well as for the purchase of a fire truck. The DRA funds also helped in the attainment of \$144,000 in FEMA funds. The combined grants total \$268,000 for the Glendora community and will significantly improve the ability of fire services to respond to the needs and safety of the people.

"The grant will make a difference for the community of Glendora," said Musgrove. "The people of Glendora deserve to feel safe and prepared for any situation that may arise, and the construction of a new fire facility and the purchase of a fire truck will help to make this possible."
