Governor Musgrove Declares State of Emergency Following Sunday Storms

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove declared a state of emergency this morning as a result of heavy storms that pounded Mississippi Sunday. The state of emergency focuses on Grenada, Hinds, Lauderdale, Lincoln, Madison, Rankin, Warren and Yazoo Counties, as well as all other areas of the state affected by the storms.

“We are working to fully assess the damage right now, so the rebuilding process can begin as soon as possible,” Musgrove said. “Our prayers also go out to those affected by the storms.”

Initial reports from the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency show a total of 11 homes and 17 mobile homes destroyed in the storm, and 2 businesses destroyed with another 14 suffering damage.
