Governor Musgrove Awards \$250,000 Grant to Town of Union

(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove has awarded a \$250,000 grant to the Town of Union through the Mississippi Rural Impact Fund Program for road improvements at the industrial park.
