## A PROCLAMATION BY GOVERNOR RONNIE MUSGROVE

**WHEREAS**, by the provisions of Section 121 of the Constitution of the State of Mississippi, the Governor is vested with the power to convene, by public Proclamation, the Legislature in Extraordinary Session whenever, in his judgment, the public interest requires it; and,

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2001, I, Ronnie Musgrove, Governor of the State of Mississippi, issued a Proclamation convening the Legislature in Extraordinary Session on Thursday, November 1, 2001, at 12:00 Noon at the State Capitol in the City of Jackson, Mississippi to consider an act to amend Section 23-15-1037, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of redistricting the congressional districts of Mississippi, and related matters; and,

**WHEREAS**, by the provisions of Section 121 of the Constitution of the State of Mississippi, the Governor is vested also with the power to adjourn the Legislature, convened in Extraordinary Session, in case of disagreement between the two houses with respect to time of adjournment, to such time as he shall think proper; and,

WHEREAS, no congressional redistricting plan has been adopted by the Legislature and there is disagreement between the two houses with respect to the time of adjournment of the Extraordinary Session inasmuch as the Mississippi House of Representatives on Monday, November 5, 2001 adjourned Sine Die and the Mississippi Senate on Monday, November 5, 2001 adjourned until Thursday, November 8, 2001:

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Ronnie Musgrove, Governor of the State of Mississippi, do hereby issue this Proclamation to adjourn the Legislature, convened in Extraordinary Session, as of Wednesday, November 7, 2001 at 5:00 p.m. until such time as I think proper to convene an Extraordinary Session to consider adoption of a congressional redistricting plan.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Mississippi to be affixed.
