Accomplishments Governor Ronnie Musgrove

Under Governor Musgrove's leadership, Mississippi has created 53,000 jobs, 2,200 new and expanded businesses and over \$14 billion in investment.

The Nissan plant opened in Canton, Mississippi, the only automobile plant opening in the nation in 2003, with \$1.5 billion invested and 5,300 direct jobs

While other states have cut spending, Governor Musgrove increased investment in education, by funding it first and investing 62% of the budget

With his Computers in the Classroom initiative, Mississippi became the first state in the nation to put an internet-accessible computer in every public school classroom, as confirmed by the National Governor's Association.

Student Mississippi Curriculum test scores increased for the second year in a row.

Mississippi's education plan was the 6th in the nation, and the first in the south, to be approved under "No Child Left Behind"

Governor Musgrove secured passage of Rural Economic Impact Authority that grants \$10 million to support worker training at our junior and community colleges and to help local communities with economic development opportunities.

Governor Musgrove reached an agreement with Governor Bob Riley to implement the East Mississippi/West Alabama Alliance, which focuses on job creation along the border between the two states.
