

A Proclamation

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 3-3-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, New Year's Day, is declared a legal holiday in the State of Mississippi; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ronnie Musgrove, Governor of the State of Mississippi, pursuant to Section 3-3-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, hereby authorize the closing of all offices of the State of Mississippi on Thursday, January 1, 2004, in observance of New Years Day.

IN ADDITION, I hereby authorize the closing of all offices of the State of Mississippi, in the discretion of the respective agency heads, on Friday, January 2, 2004, in further observance of New Year's.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Mississippi to be affixed.
