Mr. Mitchell said the fall forums titled: Women and Children First, Solutions for the Uninsured, are intended to serve as a follow-up to the Governor's Health Care Summit, Solutions for the Uninsured, held in June. Their goal is provide Mississippians with the latest information on Medicaid waivers, as well as to help Mississippians craft community strategies for preserving, strengthening and expanding the Medicaid and CHIP programs. These discussions will offer information from service providers, local policy makers and national experts on issues related to expanding coverage to parents and children.
