Additionally, the perception is that the State is holding some \$7.1 million in Federal funds in the State Treasury, pending disbursement to applicants. THIS IS NOT CORRECT. The \$7.1 million is obligated by FEMA based on *estimates* contained in the DSR's (and the attached projects). Only when the applicant submits to MEMA (which then provides it to FEMA) documentation to substantiate the DSR, is the Federal share "drawn down" electronically from FEMA.

Note also that while Category A (debris) is the only category wherein reimbursement has been made to date in Harrison County, that also represents the largest portion of eligible reimbursement.
