Governor Musgrove to Move State Government During “Capital for a Day”

Jackson, MS – Governor Ronnie Musgrove will be taking state government out of the capital city of Jackson on Tuesday, August 21. On that day, the capital of the state will be located in Ripley, Mississippi.
