I am directed by the Governor to advise you that he has approved the following House Bills:

- **H.B. NO. 833:** AN ACT MAKING A REAPPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION OF ANY MONEY IN THE STATE TREASURY TO THE CREDIT OF THE CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES EMERGENCY CONSTRUCTION FUND, FUND NO. 391G, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001. (April 24, 2000; 4:00 PM)
- H.B. NO. 834: AN ACT MAKING A REAPPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION TO REAUTHORIZE THE EXPENDITURE OF STATE GENERAL FUNDS AND SPECIAL FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED FOR CONSTRUCTION AND/OR REPAIR AND RENOVATION PROJECTS AT VARIOUS STATE AGENCIES AND INSTITUTIONS, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001. (April 24, 2000; 4:02 PM)
- H.B. NO. 846: AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE BOARD OF MEDICAL LICENSURE SHALL LICENSE AND REGULATE THE PRACTICE OF PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS; TO SPECIFY THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS THAT MUST BE MET TO BE LICENSED AS A PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT; TO DIRECT THE BOARD TO ADOPT REGULATIONS TO REGULATE THE PRACTICE OF PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS; TO PROVIDE FOR THE MINIMUM COMPOSITION OF ANY TASK FORCE APPOINTED BY THE BOARD TO ADDRESS PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT REGULATION; TO AMEND SECTION 73-43-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CONFORM TO THE PRECEDING PROVISIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. (April 24, 2000; 3:30 PM)
- **H.B. NO. 1627:** AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR FORESTERS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2001. (April 24, 2000; 4:05 PM)
