## A Proclamation by Governor Ronnie Musgrove

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of Section 3-3-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, Thanksgiving Day is declared a legal holiday in the State of Mississippi; and

**WHEREAS**, during the Thanksgiving Holiday, many State employees will travel to spend time with their families in Mississippi and in other states;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Ronnie Musgrove, Governor of the State of Mississippi, pursuant to Section 3-3-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, hereby authorize the closing of all offices of the State of Mississippi on Thursday, November 28, 2002, in observance of **THANKSGIVING DAY**.

**IN ADDITION,** I hereby authorize the closing of all offices of the State of Mississippi, in the discretion of the respective agency heads, on Friday, November 29, 2002, in further observance of the **THANKSGIVING HOLIDAY**.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF,** I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Mississippi to be affixed.
